



Conscious Planet - Save Soil

Soil is dying. Soil extinction is one of the most dangerous threats that humanity faces today – a phenomenon that has already resulted in hunger, violence, poverty, and death in many parts of the world. The rapid pace of soil degradation could soon catapult us into a global disaster.

Save Soil is a global movement dedicated to restoring soil health by bringing large-scale public awareness, shaping national and international policies, and facilitating regenerative farming models.

Three decades of hands-on conservation work with 250,000+ farmers led to the launch of the Save Soil journey by Sadhguru to draw the world's attention to the soil crisis. Between March – June 2022, Sadhguru undertook an arduous **100-day, 30,000-km lone motorcycle journey from London to southern Bharat, covering 27 countries** across Europe, Central Asia, and the Middle East. He met with leaders and citizens in each country to appeal for national policies and action that would **increase soil organic matter to a minimum of 3-6%** based on regional conditions. This would, in turn, lead to sustainable agriculture, food security, enhanced livelihoods for farmers, and climatic resilience for crops.

Save Soil played a significant role in elevating soil health as a critical climate solution at the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) COP30 in Belém, Brazil.

At COP30, Save Soil hosted and participated in several panels and roundtables on scaling soil health, climate mitigation and adaptation, resilient food systems, regenerative agriculture, and farmer-centered soil restoration. The movement was featured in major global media, including **China News, Reuters, Forbes, CNN Brazil, The Guardian, Newsweek, El País, Euronews, Yahoo Finance, NBC, MSNBC, Deutsche Presse-Agentur**, and many others, further amplifying its message.

Save Soil also launched its landmark report **Secure Soil, Save Life**, in collaboration with Aroura Soil Security Think Tank and the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) World Commission on Environmental Law (WCEL). The report received extensive global coverage with over **200 media articles**, significantly strengthening the global soil health agenda.

Other UN Engagements

At the **UNFCCC SB62 in Bonn, UN Food Systems Summit in Addis Ababa, and UNEA-7 in Nairobi**, Save Soil positioned soil as a central pillar to climate action and food transformation, engaging with key global leaders and institutions to advance soil-focused policies.



Advancing Global Soil Governance with IUCN

Save Soil worked with partners at the **International Union for Conservation of Nature** (IUCN) to advance global soil governance by co-sponsoring Motion 007 and hosting a Soil Security Conversations series. Motion 007 was adopted by majority vote as IUCN Resolution 007 at the World Conservation Congress, marking a significant step toward establishing soil security in global environmental policy.

Save Soil - Cauvery Calling

Cauvery Calling is a farmer-driven ecological movement promoting tree-based agriculture on private farmlands in the Cauvery River basin spanning the states of Karnataka and Tamil Nadu in southern Bharat. Over 40% of Cauvery River has depleted and 70% of its basin now suffers from severe soil erosion. The goal of Cauvery Calling is to enable over 5.2 million farmers to adopt tree-based agriculture and plant 2.42 billion trees on their individual farmlands, impacting 84 million people who depend on the river.

Cauvery Calling is an economic model with a significant ecological impact, marking a paradigm shift in environmental initiatives that are usually pitted against the economy. By championing tree-based agriculture on privately-owned farmlands, it aims to enrich soil quality, ensure ecological sustainability and bring economic benefits to farmers.

Cauvery Calling is an on-ground implementation of the draft policy recommendations to revitalize rivers and soil, handed by Sadhguru to the Prime Minister of Bharat in 2017. This took place at the culmination of Rally for Rivers (RfR), a movement launched by Sadhguru to save Bharat's rivers. RfR garnered the support of over 162 million people and was instrumental in the formulation of government policy for river revitalization.

Mega Farmer Conference at Hosur, Tamil Nadu

Attended by the Hon'ble Union Minister for Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare and Rural Development, **Shri Shivraj Singh Chauhan**, and held in the presence of Sadhguru, the conference convened farmers, scientists, model farmers, and policy leaders. Sadhguru urged the Hon'ble Minister to free Bharat's farmers from outdated British-era laws, treat farm-grown trees as agriculture, not forestry, and give farmers full ownership of their farm produce, including timber. In response, Hon'ble Union Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chauhan committed to involving the Cauvery Calling team and seeking Sadhguru's guidance to formulate farmer-centric policies.

Cauvery Calling provides farmers with high-quality organic saplings, on-farm consultations, handholding, and lifelong technical support. Farmers bear the costs of sapling transportation, land preparation, planting, irrigation, and long-term care, motivated by peer success stories and word-of-mouth endorsement of the model.

This farmer-led approach ensures a 70%+ sapling survival rate, maximizing impact at a minimal cost of **Rs. 42 per sapling.**



Geographic Information Systems Tracking

A dedicated GIS dashboard enables farm-level tracking of trees across the Cauvery Calling project area, presenting details such as year of plantation, species planted, and survival rate. By displaying year-wise satellite imagery for each plot, it offers clear visibility into changes and impact over time.

There were struggles like dry summers, weeding, and even a fire, but my spirit never wavered. Today, I see my farm and my son growing side by side, both symbols of a future rooted in hope.”

Innovative Interventions





Atal Tinkering Laboratories in 7 Isha Vidhya schools facilitate hands-on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) learning to foster design thinking, computational skills, adaptive learning and physical computing among students.

Online Get Mentored Sessions enable students to interact with successful professionals - this year's lineup included an Indian Army colonel, an entrepreneur, an illustrator, a dermatologic surgeon, a counselor, and a YouTuber!

Code Vidhya, starting from Class 4, offers programming and web design skills while strengthening logical reasoning, problem-solving and creative thinking abilities.

Power English Classes include a Total Physical Response activity, such as listening to music, reading, and acting, for students from Classes 1-4 who need extra support.

Learning by Exploring and Presenting for Classes 6-7 enables students to learn to organize their thoughts and express themselves effectively by making PowerPoint presentations.

Peer Learning, an interactive approach where students learn from one another through group discussions, collaborative activities, and shared problem-solving, encourages confident communication and sharpens critical thinking and narrative skills.

Self-management Spaces enable students to take full ownership of a project or event while being mentored by their teachers, helping them grow their organizational and leadership skills.

Interactive English Classes developed in-house for Classes KG-8 include stories with questions, oration, debates, PowerPoint presentations and vocabulary and grammar games.

Inspiring Curiosity and Creativity

Space Talk

With the aim of transforming the lives of Bharat's farmers from debt traps, suicide, and dwindling resources to prosperity by harnessing the power of scale, Isha Outreach's Save Soil Farmers' Movement (SSFM) brings together small and marginal farmers into Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs). SSFM also provides technical, financial, and marketing assistance to turn the FPOs into profitable enterprises.

SSFM brought together 1063 farmers to form the Velliangiri Uzhavan FPO in 2013. This initiative has since expanded to 25 FPOs as of 2025.

Isha Outreach was empanelled as a Cluster Based Business Organization (CBBO) by the Government of India in 2021.

Ponnad FPO farmers are receiving approximately Rs. 5 incremental revenue per kg compared to the market price.

Ponnad FPO, incorporated in July 2021, has achieved impressive growth, driven by a strong 92% member engagement, transparent coffee aggregation methods, and its input shop offering certified agri-lime and other inputs at subsidized rates. It has achieved a cumulative turnover of Rs. 230 million+ to date with the support of Isha's Save Soil Farmers' Movement. Before the FPO, farmers faced opaque weighing and grading practices, leading to unfair payments. Ponnad FPO transformed this by introducing a transparent coffee weighing and grading system with a hulling machine and moisture testing conducted in the presence of farmers, ensuring they received the true value of their crop. The FPO won the CII FPO Excellence Award 2024 (Market Linkages) and was invited to present its inspirational women-led model at the CII FPO Summit 2024.





The Banana mandi model is a demonstration of how market forces can be used for overall social good.

Banana farmers often struggled to get fair prices, especially for the third harvest, as traders avoided collecting small quantities, and farmers could not afford to transport their crop to markets themselves. This left them with little bargaining power and forced sales below market rates. Seeing this challenge, Bavani Amman FPO and Sathy Bhairavi FPO created an auction-based banana mandi where farmers and traders participate in transparent bidding. The mandi offers subsidized harvesting, labor, and transport. With lower commissions and quick bank payments, farmers now earn fair prices with reduced costs even for a single bunch of banana. The model has made banana cultivation more profitable for participating farmers.

"Earlier, the last 50 bunches of my bananas would usually go to waste. Since the Bavani Amman Banana Mandi was established, I have been able to sell even 1–2 clusters at a fair price, often higher than the market rate. I have participated 10 times already, and I am very grateful and happy."

Isha Gramotsavam, launched by Sadhguru in 2004 as part of Isha's Action for Rural Rejuvenation, is a unique sporting initiative that aims to rejuvenate the spirit of rural Bharat and foster a sense of community, tradition, and healthy competition. This has helped break down barriers of caste, creed, and gender, assisted youth in overcoming addictions, and provided a platform for women – who had not played a game since their childhood – to compete in tournaments.
